Creative Corner

All About...Apollo 11 by Mary J. Collins

"The Eagle has landed" (July 20, 1969)

July marks the midway point of the year. It's also considered a month of fun thanks to the biggest patriotic party of the year that starts during the first week of the month. July is also a favored month to take a vacation because of the consistently warm and sultry weather across much of the nation. In addition, this July we will be celebrating the 55th anniversary of the successful flight of Apollo 11, the first mission to land humans on the moon.

When the Apollo 11 spacecraft lifted off on July 16, 1969, for the moon, it signaled a climactic instance in human history. Reaching the moon on July 20, its lunar module—with astronauts Neil A. Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin aboard—landed on the lunar surface while Michael Collins orbited overhead in the Apollo 11 command module. Armstrong soon set foot on the surface, telling millions on Earth that it was "one small step for (a) man—one giant leap for mankind." Aldrin soon followed him out and the two planted an American flag, collected soil and rock samples and set up scientific experiments. The next day, they returned to the Apollo capsule overhead and returned to Earth, splashing down in the Pacific Ocean on July 24.

The flight of Apollo 11 met with an ecstatic reaction around the globe, as everyone shared in the success of the astronauts. The front pages of newspapers everywhere suggested how strong the enthusiasm was. NASA estimated that because of nearly worldwide radio and television coverage, more than half the population of the planet was aware of the events of Apollo 11. Police reports noted that streets in many cities were eerily quiet during the moon walk as residents watched television coverage in homes, bars and other public places. Official congratulations poured into the U.S. president from other heads of state, even as informal ones went to NASA and the astronauts. All nations having regular diplomatic relations with the United States sent their best wishes in recognition of the success of the mission.

Cats have yearned to let us know what it means to be them, Francesco Marciuliano writes in the Introduction of *I Could Pee on This and Other Poems by Cats* (2012, Chronicle). Here at last is their opportunity to express their thoughts, gripes and loves. Divided into sections on Family, Work, Play and Existence, these just-about 60 takes on what is to be a domesticated feline bring us into their world as they see it.

When I See You

When I see you head for the kitchen I know it's time for my dinner When I see you walk to the yard I know it's time for us to play When I see you go to the car I know it's time for a drive When I see you turn on the TV I know it's time for my head on your lap And when I see you climb into bed I know it's time for my walk

Dogs have no trouble communicating their feelings, Marciuliano writes in the Introduction of *I Could Chew on This and Other Poems by Dogs* (2013, Chronicle). But, "They want you to know what they ponder, what they desire and what you can do with those rain boots you just bought them." In these 60ish entries, sorted by Inside, Outside, By Your Side and Heavy Thinking, they tell us exactly.

Marciuliano is the writer of the comic strips *Sally Forth*, *Judge Parker* and the webcomic *Medium Large*. He published *I Knead My Mommy and Other Poems by Kittens* in 2014. The pet poetry books have charming and funny photographs of what might be the poems' authors.

Summer is here, and if you've been to the pool, you will have noticed the additions to the Japanese Garden. Thank you to the volunteers of the Paseo Committee for the many hours they spent cleaning, mulching and decorating the area. I'm sure everyone agrees it looks beautiful. The Hydrangea Garden is showing a lot of bud clusters. It looks like this will be a bonus year. Join us any Thursday morning at 9:30 (weather permitting) at the Clubhouse patio. To become a volunteer, just come on down and we will teach you.

July Gardening Tips

- 1. Keep deadheading spent flowers for continued bloom. Cut back to where the flower stem meets the rest of the plant to keep a tidy appearance.
- 2. To keep container-planted annuals in bloom and vibrant, fertilize regularly in accordance to the label instructions.
- 3. Be sure to keep all new plants thoroughly watered, especially during times of drought to avoid heat stress. Heat stress can also be prevalent throughout your garden beds during July and August.
- 4. To keep weeds at bay in your beds, be sure to keep weeds from making seeds. Manually remove after a rain, it will be easier.

Don't forget your houseplants.

- 1. Feed once a week with liquid fertilizer, continuing through to autumn.
- 2. Water them more regularly as the temperature warms and light levels increase, check soil before watering.
- 3. Repot any houseplants that have become root bound into a larger container.
- 4. Ensure houseplants are not getting scorched by summer sunshine, either move them further from the window or choose houseplants that will thrive in a sunny location.
- 5. Some houseplants are particularly prone to collecting dust on their leaves. So be sure to give these a regular rinse or dusting. Take large leafed houseplants outside and hose them down to clean off.
- 6. Put houseplants outside for the summer in a shaded, sheltered spot to enjoy the fresh air and extra light. They need a vacation too. By doing so, I got my orchids to rebloom.
