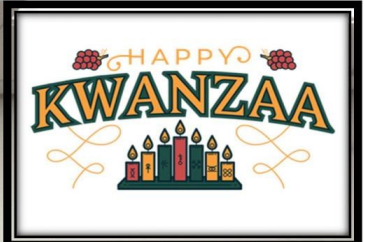

## Creative Corner

### *All About...the Long Island Expressway*

*"...the world's largest parking lot..."*

Spanning approximately 66 miles, I-495 (aka the Long Island Expressway) traverses Long Island from the Queens-Midtown Tunnel in Manhattan to Riverhead in Suffolk County. Although the Long Island Expressway name officially begins in Nassau almost all locals and most signage use "the Long Island Expressway" or "the LIE" to refer to the entire length of I-495.

According to the NYSDOT, approximately 210,000 vehicles per day travel through Queens, approximately 190,000 vehicles travel through Nassau and approximately 150,000 vehicles travel through western Suffolk.

So, the next time you are stuck in traffic on the LIE here are some interesting facts to ponder about the road everyone loves to hate.

- I-495 was constructed in stages from 1940 to 1972. Its completion was intended to alleviate congestion along local roads on Long Island. Most of the highway in Queens was built as part of the Interstate Highway System, with 90% funding from the federal government and 10% from the New York state government. The portion of the highway in Nassau and Suffolk was built with equal funding from the federal and state governments.
- The oldest tree and tallest tree in the metropolitan area, called the "Queens Giant," is very close to the LIE in northeastern Queens and is visible while driving westbound.
- Initially, I-495 lacked streetlights in Nassau and Suffolk. In 1980 plans were made to add lighting from the NYC border to Exit 64 in Suffolk. The project was completed in 2002.
- There is one HOV lane in each direction, in the median of the highway, from Exit 32 to Exit 64 that are limited to buses, motorcycles, and Clean Pass vehicles without occupancy requirement and passenger vehicles with at least two occupants.

### BOOK NOTES

#### A FRACTURED MIND

by Robert B. Oxnam

Through our interactions with others, we discover different sides of ourselves. One person may bring out our kindness, another our envy, a third our self-blame, a fourth our ability to be calm in trying circumstances, and so on.

What if, Robert B. Oxnam muses in *A Fractured Mind: My Life with Multiple Personality Disorder* (2005, Hyperion), it is those perfectly normal aspects of a personality that explode and splinter into full-fledged alters when some people who have endured extreme trauma or abuse wind up developing dissociative identity disorder (DID), formerly known as split personality or multiple personality disorder.

Oxnam, who died in April 2024 of complications from Alzheimer's at age 81, was unaware until he was 47 years old that this had happened to him. An internationally recognized expert on China, president of the Asia Society, a frequent go-to guy for television discussions of American-Asian relations, he was confronted by a family member over alcoholism so severe, he was experiencing frequent blackouts.

Oxnam made an appointment with psychiatrist Jeffrey Smith. Smith convinced him to enter rehab immediately and then to return for therapy for psychological issues that Smith could already see ran deep.

Following rehab, Oxnam went to AA meetings daily and to Dr. Smith's office twice a week. Soon discouraged by his own perception of lack of progress, he decided that at the next session, he was going to end therapy. He laid out his frustration and his decision and was surprised to hear Dr. Smith tell him their time was up. As far as he knew, he'd arrived 10 minutes ago, but Dr. Smith and Oxnam's own watch confirmed that he had been there for a full hour. Dr. Smith told Oxnam about the encounter he'd had in the interim with an angry young boy named Tommy.

Over the course of treatment, Oxnam and Dr. Smith discovered 11 distinct alters. Their stories are told in the first person by each one, switching off and taking turns. We start with Bob, who was the dominant personality when this voyage of discovery began and who at that time had no clue there were others. We learn along with them what happened in the past to make them appear, how they worked to process what had happened to them and how they navigated the work to integrate.

The book concludes with an epilogue written by Dr. Smith, *Understanding DID Therapy: The Case of Robert B. Oxnam*. He provides an overview of multiple personality, tells why he thinks it may be more widespread than we know and explains how and why therapy works for clients with and without DID.

**\*Recipient agencies will be present that day to collect the gifts**

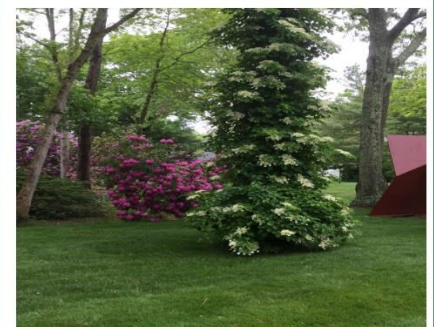

## GARDEN CORNER



How did a tropical plant become an unlikely symbol of the Christmas holiday? The history of the poinsettia, as it relates to Christmas, begins with an old Mexican legend and, later, a prominent American business venture.

Aside from the Christmas tree itself, no plant symbolizes Christmas quite like the poinsettia. Within a six-week period leading up to Christmas, there are about 35 million poinsettias sold, making it the largest potted flower crop grown in the United States.

In the native region of southern Mexico, the poinsettia flowers during the winter season. They are perennial shrubs that were once considered a weed and will grow 12 to 15 feet tall in the wild. The colored “flowers” are specialized leaves called bracts, while the actual flowers are inconspicuous beads found in the center of the bracts.

According to Mexican lore, a young child, Pepita, did not have a gift for the baby Jesus at a Christmas Eve service. She was penniless, so all she could do was pick a bouquet of weeds to offer. The angels felt compassion for her plight. So, after Pepita set the flowers at the nativity on Christmas Eve, the angels transformed the weeds into beautiful red flowers. This is why red and green are the colors of Christmas today.

Now the reason blazing red poinsettias are the Christmas flower in the US is an accidental discovery by Joel Roberts Poinsett (1779-1851), an American statesman and first US Ambassador to Mexico in 1828. An amateur botanist, Poinsett saw the red flowers when visiting the Mexican town of Taxco. Poinsett was so impressed by the beauty of these plants that he sent cuttings back to his plantation near Georgetown, South Carolina, where they were propagated and called the “Mexican Fire Plant”. The plant was shared with botanical gardens and growers across the country. Soon the plants became popular across the US and were named for Poinsett.

The reason poinsettias became so popular is due to Paul Ecke and his inventiveness. Ecke, who lived in California, discovered a technique that caused seedlings to branch, resulting in a fuller plant. He began growing the plant in the tens of thousands for Christmas when other flowers were scarce. To promote poinsettias as a Christmas plant, he sent the crimson-leaved plants to TV studios nationwide, including “The Tonight Show” and Bob Hope’s holiday specials. Today, poinsettias are the most popular Christmas plant and the bestselling potted plant in the US and Canada, contributing \$250 million to the US economy at the retail level. California remains the top US poinsettia-producing state.

For over 150 years, December 12 was considered National Poinsettia Day to honor the day of Poinsett’s death in 1851. In 2002, an Act of Congress made it official.

A few tips on caring for your poinsettia. Protect your new plants from cold temperatures and chilling winds on the way home from the store. Do not leave it in your car while you do other errands. At home, place near a sunny window where it will get bright, indirect light for at least 6 hours a day. Avoid drafts, keeping temperatures between 65-70 degrees. Over watering is a common cause of death. Water only when the soil is dry, and don’t let the plant sit in water. No fertilizer is needed while the plant is in bloom.

## Winter is on the way!

We try to ensure your safety by removing the snow and ice hazards, and ask that you take extra precautions and be very careful during these weather conditions.



### The following is the procedure for snow removal within the community as per the Operations Manager:

1. As the snow is falling during a snowstorm, plowing will begin on all roadways in the community to open them up for traffic, especially emergency vehicles. Plowing of all the roadways will begin when snowfall reaches between 1-2 inches.
2. When the snowfall slows down or stops, the crew will begin clearing all driveways with skid steer loaders. The clearing of the driveways is a priority because it creates a means of entry and exit to and from the garage door of each dwelling.
3. When all driveways have been done, the shoveling crew will be in to clear:
  - driveways of any leftover snow and apply ice-melt
  - areas by the cluster mailboxes
  - fire hydrants

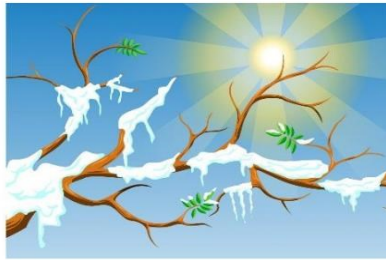
When all of these areas have been cleared, the shoveling crew will begin clearing and de-icing only the walkways of homes with entry door mailboxes.

After this has been completed, all remaining walkways will be cleared and de-iced.

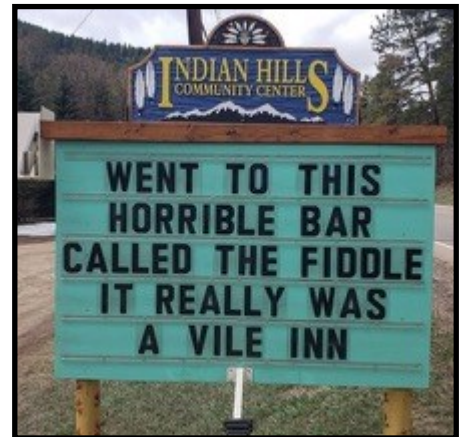



## HOLIDAY TWIRLY COOKIES



### INGREDIENTS

6 cups flour  
6 tsp. baking powder  
½ tsp. salt - mix three dry ingredients together  
½ lb. butter (2 sticks) slightly softened  
1 cup sugar  
6 slightly beaten eggs  
1-1/2 tsp. vanilla  
1-1/2 tsp. milk

### DIRECTIONS

Mix dry ingredients in a bowl and set aside.  
In another bowl, combine the slightly beaten eggs with the sugar, vanilla and milk.  
Add butter and then add flour in 3 parts to the egg mixture and lightly knead.  
Form into a dough, roll into 8" snakes.  
Fold in half, twist and shape into wreaths, candy canes, etc.  
Bake at 350 degrees for 10 to 12 minutes.  
Allow to cool completely before applying thin white icing.

### THIN WHITE ICING

1/3 Stick soft butter  
½ box confectionary sugar  
½ tsp. vanilla  
1/3 cup milk or more to make thinner.

### DIRECTIONS

Beat until smooth with electric mixer.  
Turn each cookie over and dip tops into icing.  
Sprinkle with colorful sugar (optional) and air dry.
